1.	What courses are offered at NID Jorhat?	NIDJ offers a Bachelor of Design (B.Des.) program in Textile & Apparel Design, Communication Design, and Industrial Design.
2.	How do I apply for admission?	Admission is through the Design Aptitude Test (DAT) conducted by NID. Applications are submitted online via the NID admissions portal.
3.	What is the eligibility criteria?	Candidates must have completed 10+2 (any stream) from a recognized board of education such as CBSE, IB, ICSE or equivalent. Age limits and reservation policies apply as per Government of India norms.
4.	Is there an entrance exam?	Yes, Design Aptitude Test (DAT) The Design Aptitude Test (DAT) will be conducted in two stages: Stage 1: Design Aptitude Test (DAT) Prelims Stage 2: Design Aptitude Test (DAT) Mains. the DAT Prelims and DAT Mains are mandatory for admission.
5.	Are international students eligible?	Yes, international applicants can apply, subject to NID's admission guidelines. Foreign citizens-candidates holding citizenship of a country other than Republic of India-only, are eligible to apply under the Overseas Category.
6.	What is the duration of the B.Des. program?	The program is four years full-time residential.
7.	Does NIDJ offer postgraduate programs?	Currently, NIDJ focuses on undergraduate design education.
8.	What is the medium of instruction?	The medium of instruction is English.
9.	Are internships part of the curriculum?	Yes, internships and industry projects are integrated into the program.
10.	Does NIDJ provide research opportunities?	Students engage in Design research, projects, and collaborations with industry and academia.
11.	Where is NID Jorhat located?	NIDJ is located in Tocklai, Rajabari, Jorhat, Assam, PIN-785014.
12.	What facilities are available on campus?	The campus includes design studios, workshops, digital labs, library, hostels, and co-curricular spaces.
